GERMANY AND ITALY

Agreement regarding the putting into force again of certain Conventions of Private International Law concluded at The Hague. Signed at Rome, March 23, 1928.

No. 2108. — AGREEMENT BETWEEN GERMANY AND ITALY
REGARDING THE PUTTING INTO FORCE AGAIN OF CERTAIN
CONVENTIONS OF PRIVATE INTERNATIONAL LAW CONCLUDED
AT THE HAGUE. SIGNED AT ROME, MARCH 23, 1928.

HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF ITALY and THE PRESIDENT OF THE GERMAN REICH, desiring to put into force again between Italy and Germany, certain Hague Conventions regarding international private law, have for this purpose decided to conclude an Agreement, and have appointed as their Plenipotentiaries :

HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF ITALY :

His Excellency Signor Benito MUSSOLINI, Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs ;

THE PRESIDENT OF THE GERMAN REICH :

His Excellency Herr Constantin Freiherr VON NEURATH, German Ambassador to His Majesty the King of Italy ;

Who, having communicated their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed upon the following provisions :

Article 1.

The following Hague Conventions regarding international private law shall again enter into force between Italy and Germany :

- (1) The Convention of June 12th, 1902, to settle conflicts of law in regard to marriage ;
- (2) The Convention of June 12th, 1902, to settle conflicts of law and jurisdiction relating to divorce and judicial separation ;
- (3) The Convention of July 17th, 1905, concerning conflicts of law relating to the effects of marriage on the rights and duties of the marriage partners in their personal relations, and to the property of the marriage partners ;
- (4) The Convention of July 17th, 1905, concerning the deprivation of rights and similar protective measures.

Article 2.

The present Agreement shall be ratified as soon as possible and the instruments of ratification shall be exchanged at Rome.

It shall enter into force as from the date of its ratification.

In faith whereof the Plenipotentiaries mentioned above have signed this Agreement.

Done in duplicate in Italian and German, both texts being equally valid.
