No. 4832. — SUPPLEMENTARY CONVENTION 1 BETWEEN HIS MAJESTY IN RESPECT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM, THE COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA, NEW ZEALAND AND THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA AND THE PRESIDENT OF PARAGUAY TO THE EXTRADITION TREATY OF SEPTEMBER 12TH, 1908. SIGNED AT ASUNCIÓN, SEPTEMBER 30TH, 1933.

HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF GREAT BRITAIN, IRELAND AND THE BRITISH DOMINIONS BEYOND THE SEAS, EMPEROR OF INDIA, and THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF PARAGUAY,

Desiring to make further provision for the reciprocal extradition of fugitive criminals, Have resolved to conclude a supplementary Convention for that purpose, and to that end have appointed as their Plenipotentiaries:

HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF GREAT BRITAIN, IRELAND AND THE BRITISH DOMINIONS BEYOND THE SEAS, EMPEROR OF INDIA:

FOR GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND;

For the Commonwealth of Australia;

FOR THE DOMINION OF NEW ZEALAND;

FOR THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA:

Ralph Henry Tottenham Smith, His Majesty's Chargé d'Affaires ad interim at Asunción;

THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF PARAGUAY:

Dr. Justo Pastor Benítez, Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Paraguay:

Who, having communicated their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows:

Article 1.

The High Contracting Parties agree that the provisions of the Extradition Treaty concluded at Asunción on September 12th, 1908,² shall apply to the following territories in respect of which mandates on behalf of the League of Nations have been accepted by His Majesty, viz., Cameroons under British mandate, Togoland under British mandate, the Tanganyika Territory, and Palestine (including Transjordan), (being territories in respect of which the mandates are exercised by His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland); New Guinea (in respect of which the mandate is exercised by His Majesty's Government in the Commonwealth of Australia), Western Samoa (in respect of which the mandate is exercised by His Majesty's Government in New Zealand), South West Africa (in respect of which the mandate is exercised by His Majesty's Government in the Union of South Africa), and Nauru.

Article 2.

For the purpose of the application of the Treaty of September 12th, 1908, the nationals or natives of the said mandated territories shall be assimilated to subjects of His Majesty.

Article 3.

Requisitions for extradition under the present Convention shall be made in accordance with the provisions of the Treaty of September 12th, 1908, and as if the said mandated territories were possessions of His Majesty.

Article 4.

The present Convention shall be ratified and the ratifications shall be exchanged at Asunción as soon as possible. It shall come into force one month after the exchange of ratifications in conformity with the laws of the High Contracting Parties, and shall remain in force so long as the Extradition Treaty of September 12th, 1908, and shall lapse with the termination of that Treaty.

In witness whereof, the respective plenipotentiaries have signed the present Convention and have affixed thereto their seals.

Done in duplicate at Asunción, on the thirtieth of September of nineteen hundred and thirty-three.
