| <p>2. Unless otherwise stated in these regulations, the definitions contained in the Data Protection Act shall apply.</p> | Interpretation

| <p>3. These regulations shall apply to transfers of personal data to third countries.</p> | Applicability |
| <p>4. A third country shall be any country that at the relevant time is not a Member State of the European Union.</p> | Third country |
| <p>5. Prior to transferring personal data to a third country, data controllers shall notify the Commissioner of any transfer of data resulting from a processing operation.</p> | Notification |
| <p>6. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with these regulations shall be liable to an administrative fine not exceeding twenty-three thousand and two hundred and ninety-three euro and seventy-three cents (23,293.73) for each violation and two thousand and three hundred and twenty-nine euro and thirty-seven cents (2,329.37) for each day during which such violation persists, which fine shall be determined and imposed by the Commissioner.</p> | Administrative
