Noting the statements made by the representative of France, Prime Minister of the Cameroons under French administration, to the Fourth Committee on 11 November 195822 and on 14 November 195823 and the wishes expressed by the Legislative Assembly of the Cameroons in its resolution of 24 October 1958.

- 2. Notes the statement made by the representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland<sup>21</sup> that the Cameroons under United Kingdom administration is expected to achieve in 1960 the objectives set forth in Article 76 b of the Charter of the United Nations;
- 3. Requests the Trusteeship Council to examine, as early as possible during its twenty-third session, the reports of the United Nations Visiting Mission to Trust Territories in West Africa, 1958, and to transmit the same, with its observations and recommendations, to the General Assembly not later than 20 February 1959, to enable the Assembly, in consultation with the Administering Authorities, to take the necessary measures in connexion with the full attainment of the objectives of the Trusteeship System in the two Territories.
