RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

[on the report of the Second Committee (A/49/726)]

49/134. Strengthening information systems for Africa's recovery and sustainable development

The General Assembly,

 $\underline{\text{Aware}}$ of the importance of information systems and technology for Africa's recovery and sustainable development,

Recalling Economic and Social Council resolution 1994/42 of 29 July 1994, in which the Council invited the General Assembly to review the programme budget for the biennium 1994-1995 1/ with a view to permitting the delivery of the activities of the subprogramme of the Economic Commission for Africa on statistical and information systems development, and also recalling General Assembly decision 48/453 of 21 December 1993, in which the Assembly agreed to ensure the provision of adequate staffing and resources in the subprogramme,

 $\underline{\text{Endorses}}$ resolution 789 (XXIX) of 4 May 1994 of the Conference of Ministers of the Economic Commission for Africa, $\underline{2}/$ and requests the Secretary-General fully to implement the resolution within existing United Nations resources.
