RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

[on the report of the Fifth Committee (A/48/811/Add.3)]

48/261. Decentralization of activities and resources in the fields of energy and natural resources

The General Assembly,

 $\underline{\text{Reaffirming}}$  its resolution 47/212 B of 6 May 1993, in particular section II thereof,

Recalling Economic and Social Council resolution 1993/61 of 30 July 1993, in which the Council reaffirmed its support for decentralization in order to achieve a more effective distribution of responsibilities and tasks between global, regional and national entities,

 $\underline{\text{Affirming}}$  that decentralization should have as its prime objective the efficient use of resources for more effective programme delivery,

 $\underline{\text{Taking into account}}$  the views expressed in the Fifth Committee during the forty-eighth session of the General Assembly, 1/

- 1.  $\underline{\text{Endorses}}$  the proposals of the Secretary-General contained in his report;  $\underline{2}/$
- 2. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to report on the implementation of those proposals in the context of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1996-1997, as well as in the programme performance report for the biennium 1994-1995;
- 3. <u>Also requests</u> the Secretary-General to include the related transfer of resources between sections and the resulting savings in the first performance report on the programme budget for the biennium 1994-1995;
