56/209. Role of the United Nations in promoting development in the context of globalization and interdependence

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolutions 53/169 of 15 December 1998, 54/231 of 22 December 1999 and 55/212 of 20 December 2000 on the role of the United Nations in promoting development in the context of globalization and interdependence,

- Takes note of the report of the Secretary-General;¹ 1.
- Takes note also of the deliberations of the Preparatory Committee for the International Conference on Financing for Development, to be held at Monterrey, Mexico, from 18 to 22 March 2002;²
- Stresses the importance of continued substantive consideration of the item on globalization and interdependence;
- Requests the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its fifty-seventh session on globalization and interdependence, bearing in mind, inter alia, the outcome of the International Conference on Financing for Development;
- Decides to include in the provisional agenda of its fifty-seventh session the item entitled "Globalization and interdependence".
