## **Resolution adopted by the General Assembly**

[on the report of the Fifth Committee (A/57/656/Add.1)]

## **57/319.** Feasibility of consolidating the accounts of the various peacekeeping operations

The General Assembly,

Recalling paragraph 10 of its resolution 56/293 of 27 June 2002,

*Having considered* the report of the Secretary-General on the feasibility of consolidating the accounts of the various peacekeeping operations<sup>1</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup>

1. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General<sup>1</sup> and of the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions;<sup>2</sup>

2. *Decides* to defer consideration of this question until the second part of its resumed fifty-eighth session, and requests the Secretary-General to provide a comprehensive report, taking into account the views expressed, questions raised and information requested by Member States at its fifty-seventh session, including a simulation of the options proposed.
