## Resolution adopted by the General Assembly

[on the report of the Fifth Committee (A/61/968)]

### 61/278. Consolidation of peacekeeping accounts

*The General Assembly,*

*Recalling* section VII of its resolution 60/283 of 7 July 2006,

*Having considered* the detailed reports of the Secretary-General on financial management practices<sup>1</sup> and the related reports of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup>

1. *Takes note* of the detailed reports of the Secretary-General on financial management practices<sup>1</sup> and the related reports of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions;<sup>2</sup>

2. *Decides* to revert to the consideration of this question at the first part of its resumed sixty-second session, and requests the Secretary-General to provide an updated comprehensive report on consolidation of peacekeeping accounts, including a simulation of the options proposed, taking into account the views expressed, questions raised and information requested by Member States at its sixty-first session.
