RESOLUTION 899 (1994)

The Security Council,

Recalling its resolution 833 (1993) of 27 May 1993,

 $\underline{\text{Having considered}}$ the Secretary-General's letter of 22 February 1994 (S/1994/240) concerning the matter of the Iraqi private citizens and their assets which remained on Kuwaiti territory following the demarcation of the international boundary between Iraq and Kuwait, and $\underline{\text{welcoming}}$ the developments and arrangements described therein,

Acting under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations,

 $\underline{\text{Decides}}$ that the compensation payments to be made pursuant to the arrangements described in the Secretary-General's letter of 22 February 1994 may be remitted to the private citizens concerned in Iraq, notwithstanding the provisions of resolution 661 (1990).
