RESOLUTION 1130 (1997)

Adopted by the Security Council at its 3820th meeting, on 29 September 1997

The Security Council,

<u>Recalling</u> its resolution 696 (1991) of 30 May 1991 and all subsequent resolutions, and in particular resolution 1127 (1997) of 28 August 1997,

Noting the report of the Secretary-General of 24 September 1997 (S/1997/741), and subsequent information on steps taken by the União Nacional para a Independência Total de Angola (UNITA),

Acting under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations,

1. <u>Stresses</u> the need for UNITA to comply fully with all the obligations set out in resolution 1127 (1997);

2. <u>Decides</u> that the coming into force of the measures specified in paragraph 4 of resolution 1127 (1997) shall be postponed until 00.01 EST on 30 October 1997;

3. <u>Affirms</u> its readiness to review the imposition of the measures referred to in paragraph 2 above, and to consider the imposition of additional measures in accordance with paragraphs 8 and 9 of resolution 1127 (1997);

4. <u>Decides</u> to remain actively seized of the matter.
