STOCKHOLM, November 21, 1921.

With reference to His Excellency Count Wrangel's letter of June 6, 1921, and in order to place on record the agreement between our two Governments, in accordance with the terms of the recent negotiations, I have the honour officially to declare that the Royal Government, in agreement with the Government of H. M. the King of Sweden, hereby confirms the unconditional renewal of the Berne Convention of October 14, 1890, together with all the relevant acts.

This agreement may be denounced from year to year on three months notice being given. Notice of denunciation shall be given not later than September 30, in order to take effect from

the following January 1.
