No. 477. SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT¹ TO THE MONETARY CONVENTION OF 21 OCTOBER 1943² BETWEEN BELGIUM, LUXEMBOURG AND THE NETHERLANDS. SIGNED AT BRUSSELS, ON 24 MAY 1946

The Belgian Government and the Government of the Netherlands agree to replace the sums mentioned in article 6, paragraph 5, of the Monetary Convention by the following sums: nine hundred million Belgian francs and fifty-five million Netherlands florins, and the sums mentioned in article 7 by the following sums: eighty-five million Netherlands florins and one thousand million four hundred million Belgian francs.
