Verbal Note by which the Czechoslovak Government, in pursuance of article 44 of the Peace Treaty with Italy, notified the Italian Government of those pre-war bilateral treaties between the two countries which Czechoslovakia desires to keep in force. Rome, 25 February 1948

French official text communicated by the Permanent Representative of Czechoslovakia to the United Nations. The registration took place on 9 March 1949.

VERBAL NOTE

The Legation of Czechoslovakia presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and has the honour to inform it that, with reference to article 44 of the Peace Treaty concluded in Paris on 10 February 1947, the Czechoslovak Government desires that the following bilateral conventions concluded before the war between Italy and Czechoslovakia should remain in force:

1. Consular Convention between the Czechoslovak Republic and the Kingdom of Italy concluded at Rome on 1 March 1924;¹
2. Agreement between Czechoslovakia and Italy concerning the execution of judgments in civil and commercial matters, concluded at Rome on 6 April 1922;²
3. Convention between Czechoslovakia and Italy concerning mutual protection of the rights of their respective nationals, concluded at Rome on 6 April 1922;³
4. Extradition Convention between Czechoslovakia and Italy concluded at Rome on 6 April 1922;⁴

5. Convention between the Czechoslovak Republic and the Kingdom of Italy regarding the reciprocal delivery of documents, records, and papers concerning members of the former Austro-Hungarian army concluded at Rome on 23 May 1931.¹
