A.— Note from the Royal Danish Legation, Paris, to the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs

DANISH LEGATION

The Royal Danish Legation has the honour to apply to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for its kind assistance in the following matter:

A month ago the Danish Air Navigation Company "Det Danske Luftfartsselskab", Copenhagen, applied for a concession for an air line between Paris and Copenhagen.

As the re-opening of this line is very important to traffic between Denmark and France, the Legation would be grateful if the Ministry of Foreign Affairs would kindly expedite the granting of this concession.

B. — Note from the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs to the Royal Danish Legation, Paris

4 January 1946

With reference to a note dated 17 November last, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs has the honour to inform the Royal Danish Legation that the French Government authorizes, provisionally and for a period of six months, the Danish Air Company "Det Danske Luftfartsselskab" to operate a regular air line between Copenhagen and Paris, it being understood that the RLAF shall enjoy during that period the same right with regard to the possible operation of a regular air line between Paris and Copenhagen.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs takes this opportunity to inform the Danish Legation of the French Government's desire to conclude a general air agreement with the Danish Government before the expiry of this period.
