No. 815. AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S EMERGENCY FUND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF POLAND CONCERNING THE ACTIVITIES OF THE UNICEF IN POLAND. SIGNED AT PARIS, ON 28 AUGUST 1947

## Article I

D. The Fund will make no request, and shall have no claims, for the payment for the supplies and services furnished by it under this Agreement.

## Article II

A. The Fund, after having arranged with the Government for the procedure of transfer of the supplies, will entrust...

## Article V

A. It is recognized and understood by the Government and the Fund that in order to carry out the terms of this Agreement it will be necessary to establish a close and cordial relationship of co-operation between representatives of the Government and the Fund respectively, at the operating level. To this end it is agreed that the Fund will provide in agreement with the Government duly authorized officers to be stationed in Poland, and to be available for consultation and co-operation with the appropriate officials of the Government with respect to the shipment, receipt and distribution of the supplies furnished by the Fund, to consider and review the needs of children and adolescents and expectant and nursing mothers in Poland, for the aid contemplated under this agreement, to advise the Headquarters of the Fund of the program of operations under the agreement, and of any problems which the Government may care to submit to the Fund or its representatives with regard to aid and assistance for children and adolescents and expectant and nursing mothers in Poland.

C. All Polish citizens employed by the Fund under this Agreement shall be nominated as soon as possible by the Polish Government, among adequate Polish civil servants whenever it is possible and others as required.

**D.** The Government will permit duly authorized officers of the Fund to have access to such records, books of account, or other appropriate documents with respect to the distribution of supplies furnished by the Fund, as may be necessary to satisfy the Fund of the Government's compliance with the terms of this Agreement. The Government shall further permit authorized officers of the Fund entire freedom to observe distribution of such supplies from time to time, and from place to place, and to examine the processes and techniques of distribution and make observations with respect thereto to the appropriate Government authorities.
