## Article I

D. The Fund will make no request, and shall have no claim, for payment for the supplies and services furnished by it under this Agreement.

## Article VI

A. The Fund, its assets, property, income and its operations and transactions of whatsoever nature, shall be immune from all taxes, fees, tolls or duties imposed by the Government or by any political sub-division thereof or by any other public authority in so far as it is not a case of citizens of Czechoslovakia or permanent residents thereof. The Fund...

## Article IX

This Agreement shall take effect as from this day's date. It shall remain in force at least until any supplies furnished by the Fund are consumed or used by the ultimate recipient for whom they were intended, plus a reasonable period for ...
