No. 830. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S EMERGENCY FUND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF COSTA RICA CONCERNING THE ACTIVITIES OF THE UNICEF IN COSTA RICA. SIGNED AT SAN JOSÉ, ON 14 JANUARY 1950

Article V

B. The Fund and the Government agree that, for the above purposes, the Fund may maintain an office at the capital of the Government through which its officers may be reached and through which it will conduct its principal business, should the development of the programme warrant it at a later date.

E. Should the Fund decide at a later date that the establishment of an office in Costa Rica is necessary for the effective accomplishment of the programme objectives, the Government will, in agreement with the Fund, make arrangements for, and sustain the cost of, expenses incurred in the currency of Costa Rica with respect to the establishing, equipping, and maintaining of said office together with the necessary clerical and other assistance, and postal, telegraphic and telephone communications, for the authorized activities of the officers and the office above-mentioned.
