INTER-GOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENTS OF AUSTRALIA, NEW ZEALAND AND THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND FOR THE CONTINUED OPERATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF PACIFIC AIR SERVICES BY BRITISH COMMONWEALTH PACIFIC AIR-LINES LIMITED. SIGNED AT CANBERRA, ON 27 OCTOBER 1949

His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, His Majesty's Government in the Commonwealth of Australia, and His Majesty's Government in New Zealand (hereinafter referred to as "the three Governments"),

Having formed pursuant to an Agreement dated 4th August, 1947,<sup>2</sup> a tripartite organisation registered in Australia as British Commonwealth Pacific Airlines Limited, for the purpose of establishing, operating, and developing Trans-Pacific Air Services between Australia and North America and between New Zealand and North America under arrangements to be agreed between the three Governments,

Desiring to conclude a new Agreement for the purpose of continuing on a joint basis the operation and development of such Trans-Pacific Air Services,

Have accordingly agreed as follows:

# Article I

That British Commonwealth Pacific Airlines Limited, a Company wholly owned by the three Governments and registered in Australia, shall continue the operation and development of the Trans-Pacific Services between Australia and North America and between New Zealand and North America.

# Article II

That the authorised capital of the said Company shall be such amount, expressed in Australian currency, as may be fixed from time to time by the three Governments.

### Article III

That the liability for the provision of capital required by the Company shall be borne by the three Governments in such proportions as may be fixed from time to time by them.

## Article IV

That the operation of the air services referred to in Article I shall be governed by directions given as necessary to British Commonwealth Pacific Airlines Limited by or on behalf of the three Governments.

#### Article V

That this Agreement shall replace the Agreement known as the "Inter-Governmental Agreement for the Establishment of British Commonwealth Pacific Airlines" concluded by the three Governments on 4th August, 1947.<sup>1</sup>
