No. 1226. EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN NORWAY AND LUXEMBOURG CONCERNING THE MUTUAL ABOLITION OF VISAS. LUXEMBOURG, 3 JULY 1947, AND BRUSSELS, 12 JULY 1947

Luxembourg, 3 July 1947

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the Government of Luxembourg is prepared to put into force, as from 15 July 1947, the following measures:

1. Norwegian nationals shall enter the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg and Luxembourg nationals shall enter Norway on production of a valid national passport. Such passport shall not require a consular visa.

This provision shall not apply to Svalbard, nor to Norwegian overseas territories.

- 2. Nationals of either of the two Contracting States shall be subject to the laws and police regulations in force in the other State concerning the entry, residence and employment of aliens.
 - 3. The present agreement shall come into force on 15 July 1947.
