No. 1517. AGREEMENT¹ ON COMMERCIAL EXCHANGES AND PAYMENTS BETWEEN THE FEDERAL PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF ALBANIA. SIGNED AT BELGRADE, ON 1 JULY 1946

The Government of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the People's Republic of Albania, both desiring to strengthen and extend the commercial relations between their neighbouring and friendly countries, have agreed as follows :

Article 1

The Government of the People's Republic of Yugoslavia shall deliver to the People's Republic of Albania for the period 1 May 1946 to 31 December 1946 goods of the kinds and in the quantities set out in the attached list A.²

The Government of the People's Republic of Albania shall deliver to the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia during the period 1 May 1946 to 31 December 1946 goods of the kinds and in the quantities set out in the attached list B.³

Article 2

The two Contracting Parties may agree to enlarge or amend the lists A and B mentioned in the preceding article in regard either to the quantities of goods specified therein or to other goods.

Article 3

Reciprocal deliveries of the goods specified in lists A and B and of goods later added thereto in virtue of article 2 of this Agreement shall be made in accordance with private contracts concluded respectively between Albanian and Yugoslav agencies, undertakings and individuals.

The prices in such contracts shall be stated in United States dollars according to the rate to be determined in a special protocol. For this purpose regard shall be had either to world prices prevailing on accessible markets or to competitive prices quoted in offers from other countries.

Article 4

In the absence of any provision to the contrary in a private contract concluded under article 3 of this Agreement the deliveries provided for in article 1 shall be made as follows : Albanian goods shall be invoiced free of charge at the Yugoslav-Albanian frontier or f.o.b. an Albanian port, and Yugoslav goods shall be invoiced free of charge at the Yugoslav-Albanian frontier or f.o.b. a Yugoslav port.

Article 5

The Government of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the People's Republic of Albania shall provide shipping and other necessary transport for goods to be delivered under the present Agreement.

The conditions and means of transport of such goods shall be determined by agreement between the respective agencies, undertakings and individuals of the two Contracting Parties.

Extra deliveries of kinds and quantities to be agreed on between the two Parties, having regard to the prices mentioned in article 2 of this Agreement, shall be made to the value of the aforesaid transport services.

Article 6

Payment for goods delivered and trading costs shall be made in Yugoslavia through the National Bank of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia and in Albania through the National Bank of Albania.

For that purpose each bank shall open for the other a non-interest-bearing general account in U.S. dollars and shall notify the other forthwith of every sum paid into such account.

According to such notice each bank shall make the due payment irrespective of the state of the said general account up to a maximum of 400,000 (four hundred thousand) U.S. dollars.

If, after all deliveries have been made, a balance remains in the general accounts the two Governments shall agree on procedure for settling it.

Article 7

The National Bank of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia and the State Bank of Albania shall agree on machinery for making the payments provided for in this Agreement.

Article 8

In addition to the exchange of goods provided for in this Agreement, the Contracting Parties declare that they agree to exchange of goods based on direct compensation between agencies, undertakings and individuals in Albania and in Yugoslavia, subject to existing foreign trade control regulations.

Article 9

A Joint Commission shall be established by the two Parties to supervise the operation of this Agreement.

This Commission shall meet alternately at Belgrade and Tirana at the request of either party and in any case at least once every three months to examine the results of the operation of this Agreement and to make suitable proposals.

Article 10

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of signature and shall apply retroactively to transactions carried out since 1 May 1946.

PROTOCOL¹ RELATING TO THE LIQUIDATION OF THE BALANCE IN CONNEXION WITH THE AGREEMENT ON COMMERCIAL EXCHANGES AND PAYMENTS CONCLUDED BETWEEN THE FEDERAL PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND ALBANIA ON 25 FEBRUARY 1945. SIGNED AT BELGRADE, ON 1 JULY 1946

Article 1

According to the documents submitted and approved by both Parties it has been established that Albania has delivered to Yugoslavia goods in quantities indicated in list 1² attached to this Protocol.

It has also been established that Yugoslavia has delivered to Albania goods in the quantities indicated in list 2³ attached to this Protocol.

Article 2

In accordance with the data on 1938 prices submitted by both Parties they have agreed that, in conformity with article 4 of the Agreement on commercial exchanges and payments concluded between the Federal People's Republic and Albania on 25 February 1945, the prices to be paid for the goods in lists 1 and 2 of this Protocol shall be those in list 3⁴ of this Protocol.

Article 3

Having compared the value at the prices in list 3 of the goods in lists 1 and 2 respectively, the Parties have ascertained that a credit balance of 1,794,000 (one million seven hundred and ninety-four thousand) dinars in favour of Yugoslavia remains for settlement.

The Parties have agreed that the said balance shall be settled by delivery not later than the end of September 1946 of goods of the kinds and in the quantities set out in list 4⁵ of this Protocol.

Article 4

This Protocol shall be construed with the Agreement on commercial exchanges and payments concluded between the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia and the People's Republic of Albania and shall enter into force on the same date.

PROTOCOL¹ RELATING TO THE WORK OF THE JOINT ALBANIAN-YUGOSLAV COMMISSION ON QUESTIONS RELATING TO COMMERCIAL EXCHANGES, ESTABLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 9 OF THE AGREEMENT ON COMMERCIAL EXCHANGES AND PAYMENTS CONCLUDED BETWEEN THE FEDERAL PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF ALBANIA ON 1 JULY 1946². SIGNED AT BELGRADE, ON 3 OCTOBER 1946

The said Commission, constituted by a joint decision of the Heads of Delegations of the Governments of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia and of the People's Republic of Albania on 7 September 1946, has agreed in the course of its meetings held at Belgrade from 9 September to 20 September 1946 on the following matters :

Article I

Pursuant to the provisions of articles 3 and 9 of the Agreement on commercial exchanges and payments concluded between the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia and the People's Republic of Albania on 1 July 1946, the Commission has fixed the prices of the goods specified in the quota lists A and B attached to the Agreement and also of some articles the delivery of which has been prescribed specially. The list of the prices so fixed is attached to this Protocol as annex I.³

Article II

Pursuant to the provisions of article 2 of the Agreement the Commission has prepared :

(a) A list specifying the goods and quantities which Albania desires to obtain from Yugoslavia in addition to those provided for in list A of the Agreement. Yugoslavia accordingly undertakes to assist by every possible means in the delivery of the goods specified. The list is attached to this Protocol as annex II.⁴

(b) A list specifying the goods and quantities which Albania undertakes to supply to Yugoslavia in addition to those provided for in list B annexed to the Agreement. The list is attached to this Protocol as annex III.⁵

Article III

As it was impossible in the circumstances to settle certain questions relating to commercial exchanges, and particularly to fix the prices of the foods mentioned in the supplementary lists (annexes II and III of this Protocol) and of some of the goods specified in lists A and B, the Joint Commission will be obliged to hold a further meeting as soon as circumstances permit.

This Protocol shall come into force on the day of signature.

PROTOCOL¹ RELATING TO COMMODITY PRICES. SIGNED
AT BELGRADE, ON 22 JUNE 1947

Pursuant to article 3 of the Agreement on commercial exchanges and payments signed on 1 July 1946² between the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia and the People's Republic of Albania, the Government of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the People's Republic of Albania have agreed as follows :

Article 1

The prices for goods delivered or in process of delivery under the present Agreement shall be those fixed in accordance with the annexed lists A³ and B⁴ prepared by the Joint Commission set up under article 9 of the said Agreement.

All the prices mentioned are understood to be free at the Albano-Yugoslav frontier or f.o.b. a Yugoslav or Albanian seaport.

Article 2

The present Protocol shall enter into force on the day of signature.

PROTOCOL¹ RELATING TO THE SETTLEMENT OF THE BALANCE OUTSTANDING UNDER THE AGREEMENT REGARDING COMMERCIAL EXCHANGES AND PAYMENTS BETWEEN THE FEDERAL PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF ALBANIA, CONCLUDED ON 1 JULY 1946.² SIGNED AT BELGRADE, ON 22 JUNE 1947

Article 1

The Joint Commission set up under article 9 of the Agreement regarding commercial exchanges and payments between the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia and the People's Republic of Albania, signed on 1 July 1946, has established from duly-verified documents that :

The deliveries of goods made up to 28 February 1947 by the People's Republic of Albania to Yugoslavia pursuant to the said Agreement and to list 1³ attached to this Protocol total \$1,551,226.87.

The deliveries of goods made up to 28 February 1947 by the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia to Albania pursuant to the said Agreement and to list 2⁴ attached to this Protocol total \$1,303,879.81.

In consequence of the foregoing a credit balance of \$247,347.06 appears in favour of Albania on 28 February 1947.

Article 2

The credit balance shall be settled by deliveries of goods to be made by Yugoslav State undertakings not later than 15 May 1947 according to the items, quantities and values specified in list 3⁵ attached hereto.

Article 3

The present Protocol shall enter into force on the date of signature.
