No. 1526. PROTOCOL¹ BETWEEN THE FEDERAL PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF ALBANIA CONCERNING THE CONSTRUCTION OF RAILWAY LINES. SIGNED AT BELGRADE, ON 28 NOVEMBER 1946

In order to give effect to the Agreement² concerning the establishment of an Albanian-Yugoslav company for the construction and operation of railways, the Government of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the People's Republic of Albania have agreed upon the following provisions:

Article 1

The Government of the People's Republic of Albania shall make available to the Albanian-Yugoslav company for the construction and operation of railways, sleepers, ordinary building materials and other materials which the People's Republic of Albania is able to supply, for the construction of the railway lines provided for by the Agreement concerning the establishment of the company.

The Government of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia shall make available to the company rails and any other necessary materials which it may be unable to obtain in the manner provided for in the preceding paragraph.

The Albanian-Yugoslav company for the construction and operation of railways may conclude agreements for the execution of works on railway lines with construction undertakings of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia.

Article 2

The present Protocol shall enter into force on the date of its signature. In faith whereof the plenipotentiaries of the two Governments have signed the present Protocol and have thereto affixed their seals.

Done at Belgrade, on 28 November one thousand nine hundred and fortysix, in the French language, in two copies, one for each of the Contracting Parties.
