AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT No. 1729. OF THE FEDERAL PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLA-VIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF HUNGARY ON THE DELIVERY OF GOODS (MATERIAL) TO BE MADE BY HUNGARY TO YUGOSLAVIA AS REPA-RATIONS BETWEEN 21 JANUARY 1948 AND 20 JANUARY SIGNED AT BUDAPEST, ON 17 APRIL 1948 1949.

In accordance with article 2 of the Agreement of 11 May 1946² between the Government of the Republic of Hungary and the Government of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia on delivery of goods by Hungary in compensation for the damage caused by Hungary to Yugoslavia through military operations and the occupation of Yugoslav territory, and in pursuance of the order of the Government of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia of 12 August 1946 concerning the extension of time-limits for delivery, the two Governments have agreed as follows :

Article 1

In accordance with this Agreement the quality and time-limits for delivery of the goods which the Government of the Republic of Hungary is to supply to the Government of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia between 21 January 1948 and 20 January 1949 to the value of \$US 10,000,000 are specified in Annex III³ for 1948, which is attached to this Agreement and constitutes an integral part thereof.

Article 2

Annex III of this Agreement is based on Annexes A and B of the Protocol on deliveries in 1948 concluded at Belgrade on 3 July 1947. The differences between the two documents have been agreed upon.

Article 3

All prices of goods or factory equipment not determined on the signature of this Agreement shall until finally determined be regarded as conclusive prices. The amount of an inclusive price shall in no way prejudice the establishment of the definitive price.

Article 4

Global prices for delivery of, and projected work on, plant and equipment in accordance with Annex III for 1948 (positions 25, 26, 83, 110, 137, 138, 139, 141, 166, 167, 168 and 228) have been determined subject to the condition that the work is completed up to the prescribed totals by the end of the reparations year. The representatives of the Contracting Parties shall meet quarterly to determine by agreement within thirty days the percentage of the work carried out on all plant ordered, and in accordance with that determination the work may be paid for in dollars.

In accordance with the information thus obtained the Yugoslav Reparations Delegation may use the remaining amounts for items in respect of which the work carried out has exceeded or will exceed the estimated limit, or, by agreement, to pay for the delivery of other goods.

Article 5

The time-limits for delivery of goods not ordered by the date of signature of this Agreement shall be determined by agreement between the Hungarian Reparations Office and the Yugoslav Reparations Delegation.

Article 6

The manufacture of ordered goods shall not begin until all technical problems have been settled. The Yugoslav Reparations Delegation shall do everything necessary to settle as soon as possible any outstanding problems relating to orders or parts thereof, in order that production of ordered goods shall not be hindered.

Orders for which plans or descriptions have to be approved by the Yugoslav authorities shall be returned within thirty days from the date of their submission signed or, if unsigned, with reasons for rejection, in order that production of ordered goods shall not be hindered.

Article 7

The representatives of the Yugoslav Reparations Delegation shall have charge of the acceptance for quality of goods manufactured in accordance with orders.

The Hungarian Reparations Office or the supplying firm authorized by the Office shall advise the Yugoslav Reparations Delegation of the date of delivery fourteen days before the manufacture of the goods is completed. The date thus determined for acceptance shall be strictly observed lest accumulation of goods hinder production.

Article 8

Orders not provided for in this Agreement (item 229) shall be placed by the Yugoslav Reparations Delegation under a joint arrangement concerning assortment, prices and dates of delivery of goods.

Article 9

Since the time required for the production of certain articles exceeds twelve months, the orders which have been issued under serial No. 12000 for reparations year 1948 but which will not be completed until reparations year 1949 shall not be included in Annex III of the agreement to be concluded for 1949. The Yugoslav Reparations Delegation and the Hungarian Reparations Office shall determine the time-limits for such deliveries before 30 June 1948.

Manufacture of the goods listed under item 228 which are not included in Annex III for 1948 shall be started as soon as all technical problems are settled and all plans drawn up. Nevertheless, if deliveries under item 228 are partially effected in 1948, the corresponding amount shall be charged to item 229.

Article 10

This Agreement is not subject to ratification and shall come into force on the date of its signature.
