No. 2112. MODUS VIVENDI¹ BETWEEN THE KINGDOM OF DENMARK AND THE STATE OF ISRAEL. SIGNED AT COPENHAGEN, ON 14 NOVEMBER 1952

The Government of Denmark and the Government of the State of Israel have agreed as follows:

The Kingdom of Denmark and the State of Israel shall accord to each other most-favoured-nation treatment

- (a) in matters of navigation
- (b) in any matter regarding customs duties, the mode of collecting the duties, the rules, formalities and charges relating to customs clearance, both on import and export.

Most-favoured-nation treatment shall not apply

- 1. To the privileges, accorded or which may be accorded by either of the High Contracting Parties to adjacent countries in order to facilitate trade in border areas.
- 2. To advantages resulting from any Customs Union or free trade area entered into by either of the High Contracting Parties.

The present Modus Vivendi shall come into effect as from the date of its signature. It shall remain in effect until the coming into force of a Treaty of Commerce and Navigation between the Kingdom of Denmark and the State of Israel.

Either Contracting Party may, however, terminate this Modus Vivendi at any time by giving six months' notice of such intention.
