No. 2292. PROTOCOL¹ BETWEEN DENMARK AND THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS RELATING TO THE RECIPROCAL SUPPLY OF GOODS. SIGNED AT COPENHAGEN, ON 17 JULY 1953

In accordance with article I of the Agreement between the Danish Government and the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics signed on 8 July 1946 and relating to the reciprocal supply of goods, the undersigned plenipotentiaries have agreed as follows :

The supply of goods by Denmark to the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and by the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to Denmark during the period from 1 July 1953 to 30 June 1954, inclusive, shall be effected in accordance with lists I and II appended to this Protocol and as provided in the aforesaid agreement.

DONE at Copenhagen on 17 July 1953 in two original copies, each in the Danish and Russian languages, both texts being equally authentic.
