Sir :

I have the honor to refer to the conversations which have recently taken place between representatives of our two governments relating to the economic cooperation agreement between the Government of the United States and the Government of the Union of Burma, signed at Rangoon on September 13, 1950,² and to the enactment by the Congress of the United States of the Mutual Security Act of 1951, Public Law 165, 82nd Congress.³ I also have the honor to confirm the understanding reached as a result of these conversations, as follows :

The Government of the Union of Burma reaffirms that it will act in conformity with its obligations under the United Nations Charter and in accord with the principles and purposes of the United Nations Charter in promoting international understanding and good will and maintaining world peace and eliminating causes of international tension.

I have the honor to propose that if this understanding meets with the approval of the Government of the Union of Burma, the present note and your note concurring therein will be considered as confirming this understanding effective on the date of your note.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my most distinguished consideration.
