The Belgian Embassy at Bonn presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Federal Republic and has the honour to propose, on behalf of the Belgian Government, that the Convention for the unification of certain rules relating to international carriage by air and the Additional Protocol signed at Warsaw on 12 October 1929 should re-enter into force as between Belgium and the Federal Republic.

The re-entry into force of this Convention could perhaps be effected by an exchange of letters.

The Embassy would be grateful if the Ministry of Foreign Affairs would kindly advise it of the Federal Government's response to this proposal.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has the honour to acknowledge receipt of the Belgian Embassy's Note Verbale D.9232 No. 1571 (53) dated 27 April 1953, in which the Belgian Government expresses the desire to bring into force again as between the Federal Republic of Germany and Belgium the Convention for the unification of certain rules relating to international carriage by air (First Convention for the unification of private air law) and the Additional Protocol signed at Warsaw on 12 October 1929.

The Federal Government agrees to the proposal of the Belgian Government. A notice announcing that the aforesaid Convention and the Additional Protocol are again in force as between the Federal Republic of Germany and Belgium will be published shortly in the *Bundesgesetzblatt*, part II.
