No. 2623. TRADE AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN DENMARK
AND ITALY. SIGNED AT ROME, ON 10 APRIL 1954

The Danish Government and the Italian Government, being desirous of promoting the development of trade between their countries, within the framework of European economic co-operation, have agreed on the following provisions :

Article 1

The two Governments shall apply to goods originating in and imported from their respective countries all measures taken or to be taken in accordance with OEEC decisions.

All liberalization measures taken or to be taken in accordance with such decisions shall therefore apply automatically to goods originating in and imported from Denmark or Italy respectively.

Article 2

The two Governments undertake to authorize the importation and exportation respectively of the goods enumerated in schedules A and B annexed hereto, up to the values specified therein.

Article 3

The settlement of payments relating to trade between the two countries shall be effected in accordance with the provisions of the Payments Agreement signed at Copenhagen on 4 October 1950.²

Article 4

In order to promote the development of trade between Denmark and Italy, a Joint Commission consisting of representatives of the two Governments shall be set up.

The Commission shall have the duty of supervising the application of this Agreement and of making proposals to improve economic relations between Denmark and Italy.

The Joint Commission may meet at the request of either Party.

Article 5

This Agreement shall come into force on 15 April 1954 and shall expire on 14 April 1955.
