The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to the Belgian Legation and has the honour to refer to the recent correspondence between the Director-General of the Ministry and the Belgian Minister concerning the issue of free entry visas to nationals of both countries.

The Ministry has the honour to inform the Legation that as from 1 May 1955 Israel visas will be issued free of charge to Belgian nationals in possession of a valid passport, on condition that the Belgian authorities will issue Belgian visas free of charge to Israel nationals on a reciprocal basis.

If the Belgian Government agrees to the above arrangements, it is suggested that this Note and the Legation's reply should in themselves constitute a formal agreement between the two Governments, requiring no further formalities for its application.
