No. 2938. AGREEMENT¹ ON ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE MONGOLIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC. SIGNED AT MOSCOW, ON 27 FEBRUARY 1946

The Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the Government of the Mongolian People's Republic, taking into account that the economic and cultural co-operation between the Soviet Union and the Mongolian People's Republic prevailing since the establishment of the Mongolian People's Republic has been most fruitful and has served the interests of both countries, have resolved to conclude this Agreement and have agreed on the following provisions :

Article 1

The two Contracting Parties agree to develop and strengthen the co-operation existing between the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the Mongolian People's Republic in the sphere of the people's economy, culture and education.

Article 2

On the basis of this Agreement and in execution thereof, separate treaties and agreements shall be concluded between the appropriate economic, scientific, and cultural and educational establishments and organizations of the USSR and the Mongolian People's Republic.

Article 3

This Agreement shall come into force on the date of its signature and shall be effective for ten years.

If neither of the Contracting Parties gives notice one year before its expiration that it wishes to denounce the Agreement, it will remain in force for a further ten years.

DONE at Moscow on 27 February 1946, which corresponds to the 27th day of the second moon of the 36th year of the Mongolian calendar, in two copies, each in the Russian and Mongolian languages, both texts being equally authentic.
