### Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to conversations which have recently taken place between the representatives of our two Governments regarding the issuing of gratis visas to students participating in organized study schemes and to suggest that an agreement in the following terms be concluded.

- 1) The Government of Israel shall issue gratis visas to any Netherlands subject travelling to Israel in order to participate in an organized study scheme approved by the Government of Israel.
- 2) The Government of the Netherlands shall issue gratis visas to any Israel national travelling to the Netherlands in order to participate in an organized study scheme approved by the Government of the Netherlands.

Upon receipt of a Note from Your Excellency indicating that the foregoing provisions are acceptable to the Government of the Netherlands, the Government of Israel will consider that this Note and Your Excellency's reply constitute an agreement between the two Governments on this subject, the agreement to enter into force thirty days after the date of Your Excellency's Note in reply.

Please accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
