Your Excellency,

With reference to the recent establishment of an Australian Consulate-General in Athens I have the honour to propose that, in order to enable the Consulate-General to function satisfactorily, it should be accorded by the Royal Hellenic Government the same rights and privileges as those which are, or may be accorded to United Kingdom Consulates established in Greece.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Royal Hellenic Government I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments in this matter.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
