No. 3912. PROTOCOL¹ BETWEEN DENMARK AND THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS RELATING TO THE RECIPROCAL SUPPLY OF GOODS DURING THE PERIOD FROM 15 MAY 1956 TO 14 MAY 1958. SIGNED AT COPENHAGEN, ON 14 MAY 1956

In accordance with article I of the Danish-Soviet Agreement of 8 July 1946 and

In order to give effect to the agreement on the conclusion of a two-year Protocol relating to the reciprocal supply of goods between Denmark and the USSR announced in the joint Danish-Soviet communique of 6 March 1956,

The Government of Denmark and the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics have agreed as follows :

The supply of goods by the Soviet Union to Denmark and by Denmark to the Soviet Union during the period from 15 May 1956 to 14 May 1598 shall be effected in accordance with lists I and II annexed to this Protocol and as provided in the aforesaid Agreement of 8 July 1946.

The licences required for the importation and exportation of the goods specified in this Protocol shall be issued without restriction by the competent authorities of the two Governments.

DONE at Copenhagen on 14 May 1956 in two copies, each in the Danish and Russian languages, both texts being equally authentic.
