Your Excellency

I have the honour to refer to the exchange of correspondence between our two Governments concerning the waiver of non-immigrant passport visa fees, and to propose that the Government of the Republic of the Philippines and the Australian Government agree, by Exchange of Notes, to the reciprocal waiver of non-immigrant passport visa fees for the citizens of either country visiting the territory of the other for business or pleasure for a period not exceeding 59 days.

I further propose that this agreement be made effective as of 31st March, 1960, and that it remain in force unless altered or terminated as a result of mutual consultation.

If the Government of the Republic of the Philippines is prepared to accept the foregoing proposals, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and Your Excellency's confirmatory reply thereto should be deemed to constitute and evidence the agreement reached between our two Governments in this matter.
