No. 5025. CULTURAL AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN TURKEY AND NORWAY. SIGNED AT ANKARA, ON 10 JANUARY 1958

The Turkish Government and The Norwegian Government,

Desiring to conclude an Agreement for the purpose of promoting mutual understanding between their two peoples through collaboration and interchange in cultural fields,

Have to that end appointed plenipotentiaries, who, having been duly authorized for that purpose by their Governments, have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Contracting Parties shall develop to the greatest possible extent relations between the two countries in science, literature, art and university and school education, and mutual understanding of each other's social institutions.

Article 2

In order to attain the objectives set forth in article 1, the Contracting Parties shall promote, if possible by the provision of scholarships, the exchange of representatives of scientific, cultural and educational institutions and organizations. They shall also encourage all forms of cultural activities relating to the other country.

Article 3

Each Contracting Party shall take care to draw the attention of authors and publishers to inaccuracies in text-books on either country in use in the other.

Article 4

The competent authorities of the Contracting Parties shall agree on the detailed steps necessary for giving effect to the above articles. For this purpose, a Commission shall be set up in each country to submit suggestions to the

Government regarding the application of this Agreement. The diplomatic representative of the other Contracting Party may be invited to participate in the deliberations of this Commission.

Article 5

This Agreement shall be ratified. It shall come into force immediately after the exchange of the instruments of ratification. On the expiry of five years after its entry into force it may be terminated at any time by either of the Contracting Governments at six months' notice.
