Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to our recent discussions concerning proposals for an interest-free loan by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan during the financial year ending the 31st of March, 1960. Acting upon instructions from Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs I now have the honour to propose the following terms :

- (a) The Government of the United Kingdom will advance to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan an interest-free loan of a sum of £500,000 during the financial year ending the 31st of March, 1960.
- (b) The loan shall be spent in the course of the said financial year on the development of the Desert Road between Amman and Ma'an.
- (c) The loan shall be repaid by the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan to the Government of the United Kingdom in ten equal instalments of £50,000 beginning on the 1st of April, 1965.

If the foregoing terms are acceptable to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply in that sense should be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments in this matter.

PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE

June 11, 1959

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to Your Excellency's Note No. 1112/29/59 of 10.6.1959 setting out the proposed terms of the loan which will be made by the Government of the United Kingdom to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan as follows :

- (a) The Government of the United Kingdom will advance to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan an interest-free loan of a sum of JD. 500,000 during the financial year ending the 31.3.1960.
- (b) The loan shall be spent in the course of the said financial year on the development of the Desert Road between Amman and Ma'an.
- (c) The amount shall be repaid by the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan to the Government of the United Kingdom in ten equal instalments of JD. 50,000 beginning on the 1st of April, 1965.

I wish to inform Your Excellency that the Council of Ministers of the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan has decided at its meeting held on 10.6.1959 to accept the loan in question on the terms set out above and to consider Your Excellency's Note under reference and this reply thereto as constituting an agreement between our two Governments in this matter.
