No. 6147. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN DENMARK, NORWAY AND SWEDEN REGARDING CO-OPERATION IN THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF A SCANDINAVIAN MEDICAL CENTRE FOR TREATMENT AND TRAINING IN KOREA. SIGNED AT OSLO, ON 21 DECEMBER 1956

I

The Governments of Denmark, Norway and Sweden have agreed to co-operate in the establishment and operation of a Medical Centre for treatment and training at Seoul, Korea, in accordance with the agreement with the Republic of Korea and the United Nations Korean Reconstruction Agency² (UNKRA) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Agreement") on which preliminary accord was reached during the discussions held at Seoul in November 1955.

II

The Governments of Denmark, Norway and Sweden shall each appoint two representatives and one or two alternate representatives to a Representative Committee responsible for the project. The Committee shall choose its own chairman and two vice-chairmen, who shall hold office for one year. The chairman and vice-chairmen shall each be from a different country. The office of chairman shall rotate among the three countries. The rotation principle may, however, be waived if the three Governments so agree.

III

The Committee shall appoint the Scandinavian personnel. The Committee's decision in questions concerning appointments shall be final.

IV

The Committee shall engage such advisers and experts as are required for the execution of the project.

V

The Committee shall have full powers to make any other necessary arrangements within the framework of the principal Agreement and the present Agreement and within the limitations of the sums assigned to the Scandinavian medical centre.

VI

The Committee shall submit to the Governments of the three countries questions of a fundamental nature, including those relating to conditions of remuneration and to the terms of employment generally of the personnel in Korea.

VII

The Committee shall prepare yearly budget estimates of those expenditures relating to the establishment and operation of the Medical Centre which are to be met by the three countries. These estimates shall be submitted to the Governments of the three countries for approval before they are submitted to UNKRA in accordance with article XI of the principal Agreement.

VIII

The Committee shall make proposals to the Governments of the three countries regarding disbursement authority, accounting and auditing.

IX

The Committee shall ensure that records are kept of its proceedings ; such records shall be transmitted to the Governments of the three countries.

X

The Committee shall submit a report on its activities to the Governments of the three countries twice each year.

XI

The Committee shall form a quorum when two representatives from each country are present. Decisions shall be taken by a simple majority, but if both representatives from one of the three countries are in disagreement regarding a proposed decision, they may demand the postponement of a final decision until the matter has been submitted to their own country's Government. The Committee's meetings shall be held in rotation at Copenhagen, Oslo and Stockholm unless the Committee unanimously decides otherwise.

XII

The Scandinavian Executive Officer in Korea shall be the Committee's representative to the Republic of Korea and to UNKRA in accordance with article XI of the principal Agreement. The instructions required in that connexion shall be issued by the Committee.

XIII

The remuneration of the members of the Committee shall be fixed by the Governments of the three countries.

XIV

A joint secretariat shall be established in one of the Scandinavian countries. The secretariat shall be directed by a Secretary-General in accordance with general instructions prepared by the Committee and approved by the Governments of the three countries. The Secretary-General shall be appointed by the Committee with the approval of the Governments of the three countries. The Committee shall fix the Secretary-General's salary in the light of his qualifications, but shall be authorized to take into account the temporary and special nature of the appointment. On the proposal of the Secretary-General the Committee shall appoint such office staff as is required.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the plenipotentiaries of the three countries have signed this Agreement and affixed thereto their seals.
