No. 6441. AGREEMENT¹ ON TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE STATE OF ISRAEL AND THE REPUBLIC OF LIBERIA. SIGNED AT JERUSALEM, ON 25 JUNE 1962

The Government of the State of Israel and the Government of the Republic of Liberia,

Animated by the desire to promote and to enlarge, to the greatest possible extent, economic and technical co-operation between the two countries,

Conscious of the advantages to be derived from the conclusion of an agreement on technical co-operation aimed at the encouragement of the exchange of knowledge and educational experiences, contributing thereby towards the utilisation of their economic resources, the development of their economic capacities and the greater well-being of the populations of the two countries,

Have decided to sign an agreement for technical co-operation and have duly authorised the under-named plenipotentiaries, namely,

for the Government of the State of Israel,

Mrs. Golda Meir, Minister for Foreign Affairs ;

for the Government of the Republic of Liberia,

Hon. Stephen A. Tolbert, Secretary of Agriculture and Commerce,

to sign this agreement.

Article 1

The two Governments, taking into consideration the fundamental objectives and the acquired experience of their two respective countries, have decided that the following fields are the most appropriate for co-operation and mutual assistance between them :

- a) the study of agricultural and industrial development and the training of skilled labour for purposes of such development;
- b) the study of the problems of Public Health and the training of doctors and other medical personnel;
- c) the development of professional and technical training;
- d) the development of institution of general education and scientific instruction ;

- e) the study of ways and means to improve the transport facilities and services of communication, by land, by sea and by air, and the training of the staffs necessary therefor;
- f) the planning of the exploitation of the natural and industrial resources and their development, as well as the training of experts in these fields;
- g) the teaching and education of the youth with a view to preparing it to meet the tasks assigned to it in the development of the country;
- h) the study of any other field of activity which may be agreed upon by the High Contracting Parties.

Article 2

The Government of the State of Israel will place at the disposal of the Government of the Republic of Liberia a number of scholarships and training facilities in the fields of activity mentioned in Article 1 above and, within the framework of its capacity, will send to Liberia a number of experts, in accordance with the needs of the Government of the Republic of Liberia. The number of scholarships as well as the number of experts and the conditions under which they will operate will be fixed in each case by the two Governments.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned plenipotentiaries have affixed their signatures to this present agreement which has been signed in two originals, one in the Hebrew and one in the English language, both texts being identical and equally binding, in Jerusalem, on the 25th June 1962, corresponding to the 23rd Sivan 5722.
