Dear Mr. Miller,

Referring to your letter of 29th October, 1962, about the difficulties which have arisen for the Special Fund from the fact that no direct agreement exists between it and this Government, I am authorised to inform you that the Uganda Government accepts the basic provisions of the Agreement between the United Kingdom and the Special Fund<sup>2</sup> which governed the latter's operations in Uganda before independence, and that it is willing to consider itself as the successor to the United Kingdom Government with respect to Uganda under that Agreement. This arrangement will apply
