EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND JORDAN CONCERNING A LOAN BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN DURING THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING MARCH 31, 1964. AMMAN, 25 AND 27 APRIL 1963

Her Britannic Majesty's Ambassador at Amman to the Prime Minister of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan

BRITISH EMBASSY

Your Excellency,

Amman, April 25, 1963

I have the honour to refer to our recent discussions concerning proposals for an interest-free loan by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan during the financial year ending the 31st of March, 1964. Acting upon instructions from Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, I now have the honour to propose to Your Excellency the following terms :

(A) The Government of the United Kingdom will advance to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan an interest-free loan of the sum of £700,000 sterling during the financial year ending the 31st of March, 1964.

(B) This sum of money will be allocated as follows :

(i) Desert Road Carpet	200,000
(ii) Continuation of support for the Central Water Authority on Water Development Schemes already undertaken or to be agreed upon	250,000
(iii) Survey and engineering studies for the Wadi Araba Road	70,000
(iv) Survey and engineering studies for the extension of Amman Airport	25,000
(v) To be allocated in a later exchange of notes by agreement between the two Governments	155,000

(C) The payment of £200,000 sterling for the Desert Road carpet shall represent a contribution amounting to two-thirds of the total allocated expenditure on this

item during the financial year ending the 31st of March, 1964, in consideration of which the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan will contribute the remaining one-third amounting to the equivalent of £100,000 sterling.

(D) The loan shall be repaid by the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan to the Government of the United Kingdom in ten equal annual instalments of £70,000 beginning on the 1st of April, 1969.

If the foregoing allocation is acceptable to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply in that sense should be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments in this matter.
