The Embassy of Italy presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and has the honour to inform it that the Italian Government would be prepared to abolish, on a basis of reciprocity, the visa requirement for Israel diplomatic passports.

If the Israel Ministry of Foreign Affairs agrees, this abolition could take effect on 1 November 1961.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to the Embassy of Italy and has the honour to acknowledge receipt of the Embassy's Note No. 3431 of 24 August 1961, by which it informed the Ministry that the Italian Government would be prepared to abolish, on a basis of reciprocity, the visa requirement for Israel diplomatic passports and that this abolition could take effect on 1 November 1961.

The Ministry is happy to inform the Embassy that this proposal has been approved by the Government of the State of Israel and that consequently Italian

diplomatic passports will be exempt from the visa requirement from 1 November 1961 onwards, it being understood that the aforementioned Note from the Embassy and this Note shall constitute the formal agreement concluded on the subject between the two Governments.
