No. 7472. EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN ISRAEL AND YUGOSLAVIA CONCERNING ABOLITION OF VISA FEES. BELGRADE, 20 MAY AND 13 JUNE 1964

The Legation of Israel presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and, with reference to the Ministry's Note of 29 January 1964 concerning the abolition of visa fees between Israel and the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, to the Israel Legation's Note of 26 March 1964, and to the discussions which have taken place in the meantime between the Ministry and the Israel Legation, has the honour to propose to the Ministry that an agreement be concluded in the following terms :

1. Israel citizens holding valid passports shall be exempted from payment of fees on Yugoslav entry visas for visitors (including tourists) issued for one or more entries, and also on transit visas and exit visas.

2. Yugoslav citizens holding valid Yugoslav passports shall be exempted from payment of fees on Israel entry visas for visitors (including tourists) issued for one or more entries, and also on transit visas.

3. If the foregoing proposals are acceptable to the Government of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, the Legation also proposes that this Note and the reply of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs should be regarded as constituting an agreement between the Governments of Israel and Yugoslavia which will enter into force on 15 July 1964 and may be terminated at any time by either of the two Governments, subject to one year's notice of termination.

The Legation of Israel takes this opportunity, etc.
