Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that the Government of Guyana accepts the provisions of the Agreement between the United Kingdom and the United Nations Special Fund² which governed the latter's operations in Guyana before independence, and that it is willing to consider itself as the successor to the United Kingdom Government with respect to Guyana under that Agreement.

Accordingly, for all Plans of Operation relating to UNDP (Special Fund) projects currently in operation in Guyana, the Government will apply the provisions of the Agreement referred to above, and it will likewise apply them to the Plans of Operation for projects which may be approved in the future.

This arrangement will apply until such time as an Agreement between this Government and the UNDP (Special Fund) relating to assistance from the latter is signed and comes into force.
