Sir,

I am writing on behalf of the United Nations Development Programme and have the honour to propose that, following the independence of Guyana on 26 May 1966 and until such time as a standard agreement for the provision of operational assistance is signed between the Government of Guyana and the United Nations Development Programme, both the Government of Guyana and the United Nations Development Programme will apply the provisions of the Agreement for the Provision of Operational and Executive Personnel signed on 27 June 1963<sup>2</sup> between the United Nations and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, acting on behalf of the Trust, Non Self-Governing and other Territories for whose international relations the Government of the United Kingdom is responsible.

I should appreciate it if you will kindly indicate your Government's acceptance of this proposal.
