No. 8314. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE POLISH PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF GHANA ON CULTURAL CO-OPERATION. SIGNED AT ACCRA, ON 17 JANUARY 1964

The Government of the Polish People's Republic and the Government of the Republic of Ghana

Desirous of promoting co-operation in the fields of Education, Science, and Culture between their two States,

Convinced that such co-operation will serve to strengthen the bonds of friendship between their two States,

Have decided to conclude an Agreement on Cultural Co-operation,

Stipulating that all exchanges in the fields of Education, Science and Culture are for mutual benefit, and are to be effected within the framework of the Laws of each Contracting Party, and

Pledging Friendship, Peaceful Relations, Mutual Respect for National Sovereignty, Equality and Non-Interference with each other's Domestic Affairs; and to this end

Have agreed upon the following;

Article I

The Contracting Parties have agreed to promote mutual co-operation in the fields of education, science, culture and information.

Article II

The Contracting Parties have agreed to develop in particular : Co-operation between their universities, colleges, scientific and research institutions, associations and other cultural and educational organizations; mutual exchange of information and materials in the fields of education, science and culture; organization of conferences and exchange of personnel dealing with educational, scientific and cultural activities; exchange of scientific, technical, literary and art works and publications together with their translation where necessary; exchange of films; organization of concerts, theatre performances, technical exhibitions and sporting events.

Article III

Each of the Contracting Parties undertakes to allow employees and nationals of the State of the other Contracting Party sponsored by that Contracting Party to carry out research work and to pursue studies at the universities, colleges, archives, libraries and museums of its country within the framework of the laws governing those institutions.

Article IV

Each of the Contracting Parties will within its own territory and educational, cultural, scientific and industrial institutions facilitate the granting of scholarships and other material assistance to students, technicians, engineers, scientists, and artists of the other Contracting Party for the pursuit of studies, the carrying out of scientific and other research work and the acquisition of specialist qualifications, skills and techniques.

Article V

The two Contracting Parties will promote the development of co-operation between their respective radio and television organizations, press agencies and cinematography institutions.

Article VI

Each of the Contracting Parties undertakes to provide for the organization of special courses at its universities or other educational institutions for the purpose of teaching the languages, literature and culture of the people of the other Contracting Party.

Article VII

To achieve the aims of the present Agreement the Contracting Parties will draw up plans for periods of one or two years on co-operation in the fields of education, science and culture. Each plan will be agreed upon by the appropriate organs of the Contracting Parties. The plans will be drawn up alternately at Warsaw and Accra by representatives appointed by both Contracting Parties.

Article VIII

All problems of financing with regard to the implementation of this Agreement shall be settled on the basis of reciprocity.

Article IX

The present Agreement is subject to ratification and shall come into force on the day of the exchange of instruments of ratification which will take place in Warsaw.

Article X

The present Agreement may be amended or terminated upon the expiration of a 6 months period from the day one of the Contracting Parties gives notice to the other of its desire to amend or terminate the Agreement.

DONE at Accra on the 17th day of January, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Four, in two originals, each of them in the Polish and English languages, both texts being equally authentic.
