Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the independence of The Gambia on the 18th of February, 1965 and, in regard to the obligations and responsibilities and the rights and benefits which, by virtue of any valid international instrument, related to The Gambia immediately before that date, to state that it is the understanding of the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland that the Government of The Gambia are in agreement —

- (i) that all obligations and responsibilities of the Government of the United Kingdom which arose from any valid international instrument applying to The Gambia immediately before the 18th of February, 1965 continued to apply to The Gambia and were assumed by the Government of The Gambia as from that date; and
- (ii) that the rights and benefits enjoyed by the Government of the United Kingdom by virtue of the application of any such international instrument to The Gambia continued to be enjoyed by the Government of The Gambia.

I shall be grateful for your confirmation that the Government of The Gambia are in agreement with the foregoing and that this Letter and your reply to that effect shall constitute an agreement between the two Governments.
