Sir,

I am writing on behalf of the United Nations Development Programme and have the honour to propose that, following the independence of Lesotho on 4 October 1966 and until such time as an Agreement between the Government of Lesotho and the UNDP (Special Fund) relating to assistance from the latter is signed and comes into force, the Government of Lesotho accept the provisions of the Agreement between the United Kingdom and the United Nations Special Fund which governed the Special Fund operations in Lesotho before independence, and that the Government are willing to consider themselves to be the successor to the United Kingdom Government with respect to Lesotho under that Agreement.

Accordingly, for all Plans of Operation relating to UNDP (Special Fund) projects currently in operation in Lesotho, the Government will apply the provisions of the Agreement referred to above and will likewise apply them to the Plans of Operation for projects which may be approved in the future.
