No. 8614. AGREEMENT³ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF ALGERIA AND THE INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANISATION CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN OFFICE OF THE ORGANISATION IN ALGIERS. SIGNED AT ALGIERS, ON 6 APRIL 1967

Whereas the International Labour Organisation has decided to establish an Office of the International Labour Organisation in Algiers, and

Whereas the Government of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria has conveyed to the International Labour Organisation that it is prepared to grant that Office all the necessary facilities ;

The Government of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria and the International Labour Organisation are agreed as follows :

Article 1

The Government of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria will afford every assistance within its power to secure the necessary facilities for the Office of the International Labour Organisation in Algiers.

Article 2

The Government grants the Office of the International Labour Organisation and the personnel of the Organisation assigned to that Office the privileges and immunities provided for in the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the Specialised Institutions of 21 November 1947.⁴

Article 3

The Government will facilitate the entry, movements and stay in Algeria of the personnel assigned to the Office of the International Labour Organisation in Algiers and of persons who travel there on official business, as well as their departure from the country.

Article 4

The Government will afford the International Labour Organisation all the assistance in its power to facilitate the obtention of suitable offices, equipped as necessary with telephone, water and electricity.

Article 5

1. This Agreement shall come into force on the date of its signature.
2. This Agreement will remain in force while the Office of the International Labour Organisation remains established in Algiers.
3. This Agreement may be modified by the mutual consent of the two parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned duly authorised representatives of the Government and the International Labour Organisation have signed this Agreement.
