No. 8677. AGREEMENT<sup>3</sup> BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF  
SENEGAL AND THE INTERNATIONAL LABOUR OR-  
GANISATION CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT  
OF AN OFFICE OF THE ORGANISATION AT DAKAR.  
SIGNED AT DAKAR, ON 9 FEBRUARY 1967

Whereas the International Labour Organisation has decided to establish an Office of the International Labour Organisation at Dakar, and

Whereas the Government of Senegal has informed the International Labour Organisation of its readiness to grant all necessary facilities to that Office :

The Government of Senegal and the International Labour Organisation have agreed as follows :

*Article 1*

The Government of Senegal shall afford every assistance within its power in securing the necessary facilities for the Office of the International Labour Organisation at Dakar.

*Article 2*

The Government shall grant to the Office of the International Labour Organisation and to the staff of the Organisation appointed to the said Office the privileges and immunities provided for in the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the Specialised Agencies of 21 November 1947<sup>4</sup>.

*Article 3*

The Government of Senegal shall facilitate the entry into and the stay in Senegal of the persons invited to go to the Office of the International Labour Organisation for official purposes, and their departure from the country.

*Article 4*

The Government of Senegal shall afford the International Labour Organisation every assistance within its power in securing appropriate office accommodation and necessary telephone, water and electricity installations.

To that effect, it agrees to place at the disposal of the Office of the International Labour Organisation premises suitable for use as offices and a residence for the Director.

*Article 5*

The Government of Senegal shall grant the Office of the International Labour Organisation and its staff treatment which shall not be less favourable than that granted in general to other inter-governmental or international organisations having a representative at Dakar.

*Article 6*

1. This Agreement shall come into force on signature.
2. The Agreement shall remain in force while the Office of the International Labour Organisation remains established at Dakar.
3. The Agreement may be modified by mutual consent.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned duly authorised representatives of the Government of Senegal and the International Labour Organisation respectively have signed the present Agreement this ninth day of February 1967, in two copies in the French language.
