Subject: Reciprocity for Amateur Radio Licensees

Reference: Your letter HML 59216-8/66

Gentlemen:

I have the honour to inform you that this Administration is prepared, according to your suggestion, to enter into a reciprocal agreement providing for exception of Israeli licensed radio amateurs from Austrian amateur examination requirements in the subjects "Transmitting and Receiving Technology" and "Operation and Qualifications", and for exemption of Austrian amateur licensees from the Israeli Grade "B" examination requirements in the comparable subjects, as described in the enclosed syllabus.

If your Administration is prepared to enter into an agreement in these terms, your affirmative reply taken together with this letter would be regarded by this Administration as constituting such an agreement, effective from the date of your reply and subject to termination by either party giving the other six months' notice in writing of its intention to terminate.

Gentlemen:

With reference to your letter dated March 23, 1967, File No. 30 SR 222 (4), we wish to thank you for your willingness to enter into a reciprocal agreement regarding the recognition of the examinations.

By virtue of this agreement, citizens of Israel holding a Grade "B" Amateur Radio Operator Certificate of the State of Israel will be exempted, at their request, from the examination in the subjects "Transmitting and Receiving Technology" and "Operation and Qualifications".

In conformity with your letter, the agreement in question shall enter into force as of this date. It may be terminated by either party by giving written notice to the other, in which case the agreement will continue in force throughout six months following such notice of termination.
